Optionally, Candidates can also submit a bio of a maximum of 250 words that will be posted on the CSU's election web platforms and shall be included as a viewable text on the online ballot. The biography can include your platform, experience, etc. **Nomination forms will not be accepted if the short bio (75 words max) is not included at the time of submission.**



To become a candidate for the **CSU executive**, a nominee must gather the signatures of at least **120 eligible voters** for the position in which they are running. To become a candidate for **CSU senate/council**, a nominee must gather the signatures of at least **40 eligible voters** from their **own faculty**. All signatories must be registered undergraduate students as of January 29, 2025. Signatories must fill in all fields to be counted. It is recommended that you collect extra signatures just in case some of the signatures you collect are from students that are in the wrong faculty (ie grad students) and/or are misspelled. **PLEASE TYPE THE FULL NAME OF THE APPROPRIATE FACULTY.**
